

### Tuition Fees

The total tuition for the Blended Learning Part-Time MBA program is \$57,500 and is to be paid in the form of a \$2,000 deposit upon acceptance of a candidate's offer of admission, and 9 payments of \$6,388.00, with the deposit applied towards the first instalment. All McMaster graduate students are also required to pay an approximately \$20 athletics and recreation fee each term (*note: this is a mandatory fee that all students at McMaster are required to pay*).

**Instalment 1:** August 1, 2021 (\$4,388.00 + \$21.31)

**Instalment 2:** January 2, 2022 (\$6,388.00 + \$21.31)

**Instalment 3:** April 1, 2022 (\$6,388.00 + \$21.31)

The installment schedule repeats for three years, totaling 9 (nine) installments.

With the current economic challenges, McMaster has created some options to hopefully help reduce the financial stress. For the 2021/22 academic year, students will have the option to enrol in a **payment plan**.

The payment deadlines outlined above will remain; however, you can now choose to pay these fees in equal amounts over the four months of each term. No interest will be charged during the four months, but there will be a one-time deferral fee of \$80 for students choosing this option each term. [Find out more about your payment options.](#)

**Due to the high demand for this program, these are firm deadlines and you will not be given access to the semester's course materials until your fees have been paid.**

Your tuition fees will include breakfast, coffee breaks, and lunches at in-person residencies, technology licenses, some course materials, and on-site parking during the residencies. These fees do not cover transportation to and from residencies, any necessary hotel accommodations, dinners (unless otherwise noted), or textbooks. Your first semester course materials will be covered by the program. We anticipate that textbooks in subsequent semesters will cost no more than \$400 per semester.

### Payments

The Blended Learning Part-Time MBA program follows an academic schedule that varies slightly from traditional McMaster academic terms. Because we are still using the admissions and payments system employed by the broader University, tuition charges may not reflect accurately in your Mosaic Student Centre. Please be advised that your first year tuition payments are still due according to the schedule above. ### Tax Forms

You will receive access to your T2202A (Tuition, Education, and Textbook Amounts Certificate) in February through your Mosaic Student Centre. Please note that your second instalment (due January 2, 2022) is officially part of the Winter 2022 academic term and while you are welcome to make a payment in December 2021, it will not reflect on your T2202A until 2022.

The entirety of your tuition less a small student services fee is tax deductible and will be reflected as such on your T2202A. This small fee is incorporated in your total tuition amount.

If your employer is sponsoring you, you may not be entitled to a tax deduction. Please consult the Canada Revenue Agency if you have any specific questions.
